NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS
PLEASE READ BEFORE ENTERING

1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON SHOW GROUNDS.**
2. **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump**
3. Entry fees \$24 / 1st , \$13/add'l entry / same dog/day (\$3+\$3 AKC recording fees included).
4. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
5. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AKC agility rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
6. A refund of entries minus AKC fee plus \$10/dog/day for bitches in season or injured dogs will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be made no later than 48 hrs after close of the show. A Veterinarian's note and Final Trial Confirmation for dog must accompany any such refund request.**
7. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
8. Telegraph, telephone, fax, online and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
9. All calls to the Trial Secretary before 8 PM will be returned collect to the caller.
10. **Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules printed on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT acceptable and will be returned!**
11. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club Treasurer will add a collection fee of \$50.00 to the amount of each returned check.
12. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such error.
13. **Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the show site. Failure to do so will result in dismissal**
14. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
15. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up the judging schedule. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the agility ring when called to be judged.
16. It is expressly understood that every dog and child at this trial are in the care, custody and control of its owner, handler, or parent during the entire time the dog or child is on the trial premises. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or child create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
17. Neither Nita-Nee KC nor Grange Fairgrounds are responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.

Declination of Entries: Nita-Nee KC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Nita-Nee KC or any official thereof.

Any refunds owed will be mailed after the trial by club Treasurer.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Regular Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height **Preferred** -The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	<u>Regular</u>	<u>Preferred</u>
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches at the withers	24 inches	20 inches
Dogs may be entered at owner discretion	26 inches	

MEASURING

All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs **except those jumping 24" (unless a VMO or AKC Rep is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards must be measured. If you have a height card, please submit a copy with your entry.

COURSE WALK THROUGHS AND WARM-UPS

There will be **NO** equipment familiarization for Novice classes.

RIBBONS

A Dark Green Qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the four top qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue Rosette
Second Place	Red Rosette
Third Place	Yellow Rosette
Fourth	White Rosette

A qualifying score required for all prizes. New Title, MACH and PAX ribbons and bars are available. Toys are given for each placement.

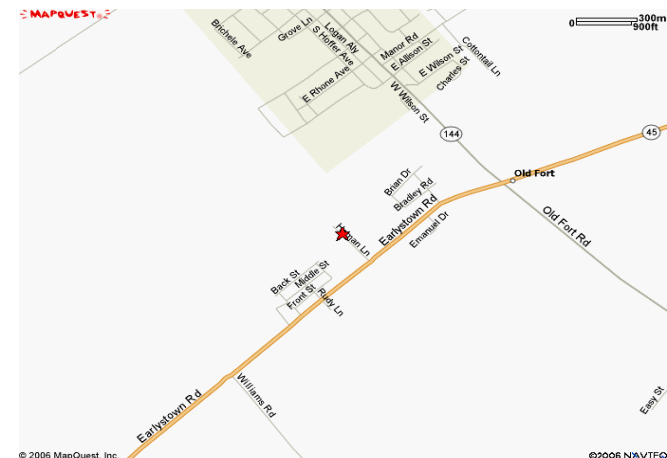
DIRECTIONS

From Harrisburg and points south and southeast: Take US 22/322 west out of the Harrisburg area to Lewistown. At Lewistown take US 322 west. At the base of Seven Mountain (after the road becomes two-lane) the road comes to a Y. Bear right onto PA 144 (**DO NOT TAKE TRUCK ROUTE PA 144**). Follow PA 144 for 3.9 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of PA 45 and PA 144. Turn left onto PA 45 and follow it for 0.5 mi. Turn right onto Homan Lane and go straight into the Grange Fair grounds. (Watch for signs) The trial site is on the right after the entrance gates.

From Altoona and points south and southwest: Take I99/US220 north from Altoona. As the 4-lane highway ends at the village of Bald Eagle, turn right and follow US 220 north (2-lanes) to Port Matilda. At the traffic light in Port Matilda, US 322 east joins US 220 north. Stay on US 220 (north)/US 322 (east) to the outskirts of State College. The road will become 4-lane again. At the exit for Penn State University bear right and follow US 322 east. At the exit for PA 45 east get off and turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Follow PA 45 east for 6.2 miles and turn left onto Homan Lane. Go straight on Homan lane into the Grange Fair Grounds. (Watch for signs) The trial site is on the right after the entrance gates.

From Lewisburg and points directly east: Take PA 45 west from Lewisburg 43.7 miles to Old Fort. At the traffic light in Old Fort, go straight for 0.5 miles. Turn right onto Homan Lane and go straight into the Grange Fair grounds. (Watch for signs) The trial site is on the right after the entrance gates.

From east or west via I-80 and all points north of I-80: Take I 80 to the Bellefonte exit (#161) Get off and go south on PA 26/US 220. Take the Pleasant Gap exit for PA 26 (south)/PA 64 (north). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto PA 26 south. Proceed approximately 1 mile to a traffic light. Turn left onto Harrison Rd. and proceed about 0.6 mile. Turn left onto PA 144 south (Main St.). Proceed on PA 144 south for 4.7 miles to the traffic light in Old Fort at the intersection with PA 45. Turn right onto PA 45 west and proceed 0.5 mile. Turn right onto Homan Lane and go straight into the Grange Fair grounds. (Watch for signs) The trial site is on the right after the entrance gates.

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as the result of qualifying for an agility title, provided the request is made in writing or by email to the Trial Secretary by 6PM on Monday, May 26, 2008 for Saturday and by close of trial Saturday for the next day's classes. Dogs moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.

Eligibility Statement

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an ILP/PAL number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
